



ACTION ALERT

Yesterday, FASA's lawsuit seeking to have constitutional amendments 7 and 9 removed from the November ballot was rejected. In an unexpected decision, the Court ruled in favor of the Tax Reform Budget Commission as the Judge chose not to strike the Amendments from the ballot.

While we intend to appeal this decision, it is now unlikely that we will get a final ruling prior to the November 4 election. The ruling means amendments 7 and 9 remain a serious threat to Florida schools. FASA's grass-roots political action campaign is now our only defense against the largest expansion of vouchers in the nation.

In more bad news for public schools yesterday, Governor Crist press, for the first time, indicated his support for Amendment 5.
