

**Florida Association of Student Councils
High School Student of the Year**

In order to receive this award a student must be in high school (grades 9 through 12) and be nominated by his/her student council. The nomination packet must include a letter from the student council advisor, the student council president (or from another officer appointed by the advisor in the event that the president is the nominee) and the school's principal. The letters must include evidence of the following:

- 1) The nominee is open to new ideas from his/her peers.
- 2) The nominees are willing to work well with all students.
- 3) The nominee is supportive of all student council activities.
- 4) The nominee demonstrates an interest in a wide area of student concerns.

The student must be in attendance at the annual FASC convention to receive this award.

The same student may be nominated a number of times by his/her student council however; once a student receives this award he/she is ineligible to receive it again.

The nominee does not have to be an officer in his/her school's student council but must have been a student council member for at least one full school year.
