### FASA Individual Member (\$ 217.00)

Open to principals\*, assistant principals\*, superintendents and other district office school administrators. Includes public virtual and charter school types. Individual member receives all FASA benefits. Payroll deduction for dues is available in most districts. Membership is owned by the individual and is not transferable. **\*Due to a joint membership agreement, public elementary principals and assistant principals joining FASA must also join NAESP.**

### FASA Institutional Member (\$217.00)

Open to principals\*, assistant principals\*, superintendents and other district office school administrators. Includes public virtual and charter school types. Institutional member (one designee per membership) receives all FASA benefits. Dues are paid by the institution. Membership is owned by the institution and is transferable. **\*Due to a joint membership agreement, public elementary principals and assistant principals joining FASA must also join NAESP.**

### FASA Associate/Aspiring/College, University/Private School Member (\$100.00)

Open to aspiring administrators, graduate students, teachers, professors, and private school administrators. Member receives all benefits except legal defense, voting and board privileges. Payroll deduction for dues is available in most districts for public school district employees.

### FASA Basic Retired (\$100.00)    Full Service Retired (\$217.00)

Open to previous active members who have retired and no longer hold an administrative position. Basic member receives all benefits except legal defense and board privileges. Full service member receives all benefits except legal defense.
